

BURBANK BLVD–LANKERSHIM BLVD TO CLEON AVE WIDENING PROJECT

The City of Los Angeles (City) will widen approximately 0.7 mile of Burbank Boulevard by 12 feet on both sides between Lankershim Boulevard and Cleon Avenue to Major Highway Standards. The proposed improvements include the construction of concrete curb, gutter and sidewalks; asphalt concrete pavement; storm drain and sanitary sewer facilities, street trees, street lighting, traffic signals and possibly green street elements.

In order to widen the street, all utilities along Burbank Boulevard between Lankershim Boulevard and Cleon Avenue will need to be relocated and new sidewalk will be constructed. Also, any encroachments in the City's right of way will need to be removed and relocated. From April 19, 2021 to April 28, 2021, the City provided survey marks at each affected private property to identify the encroachments onto the City's right of way, which includes but is not limited to a wrought iron/chain link fencing and signage.

In order to meet the Project timeline to commence construction in early January 2022, the City requests for your immediate attention to remove the encroachments in the City's right of way. Please remove the encroachment no later than 30 days from the date when StreetsLA Investigation and Enforcement Division has contacted you.
