## PARTHENIA STREET AND SEPULVEDA BOULEVARD STREETSCAPE AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

## LOCATION:

Parthenia Place between Sepulveda Boulevard and Columbus Avenue.

## **DESCRIPTION:**

#### Phase I

A 60-foot wide roundabout and Class IV two-way separated bikeways to be constructed at Parthenia Place and Columbus Ave.

#### Phase II

Located at Sepulveda Blvd. and Parthenia Place: New stop-controlled, right turn only street and two large pedestrian median islands.

### Both phases will entail new pedestrian improvements, including:

- Curb extensions
- Pedestrian refuge median islands and alterations
- ADA compliant curb ramps, driveway and sidewalk improvements

- Sidewalk 12,350 SF
