

PARTHENIA STREET AND SEPULVEDA BOULEVARD STREETSCAPE AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

LOCATION:

Parthenia Place between Sepulveda Boulevard and Columbus Avenue.

DESCRIPTION:

Phase I

A 60-foot wide roundabout and Class IV two-way separated bikeways to be constructed at Parthenia Place and Columbus Ave.

Phase II

Located at Sepulveda Blvd. and Parthenia Place: New stop-controlled, right turn only street and two large pedestrian median islands.



Both phases will entail new pedestrian improvements, including:

- Curb extensions
- Pedestrian refuge median islands and alterations
- ADA compliant curb ramps, driveway and sidewalk improvements
- Street trees and landscaping treatments
- Bicycle lane improvements along Parthenia Place

- Curb Extensions – 6
- Curb Ramps – 14
- Midblock Ramps – 2
- Sidewalk – 12,350 SF
- Median Alterations – 4
- New Median Islands – 6
- Driveways – 2
- Bike Lane Striping – 815 LF
- Class IV Bike Lane – 415 LF
- Landscaping – 4,250 SF
- Street Trees – 6
- New Striping and Signage
